An Intermodal Transportation Center (ITC) is a transportation hub that enables people to transfer comfortably and conveniently between transportation modes such as regional bus, local transit, car sharing services (like Zipcar), bicycling, walking, and a variety of other transportation options. An ITC can also serve as an activity center and an economic driver in a community. Southwest Region Planning Commission (SWRPC) is conducting a feasibility study on how such a facility may benefit Keene and the Region.

If you'd like to learn more, you're invited to explore the project posters that will be on display in the atrium of the Keene Public Library from January 28th to February 4th. The posters will illustrate how different scenarios of future growth in the Keene area could affect the built environment, transportation options, and ITC design. SWRPC staff will be available on-site for informal discussion about the study on February 4th from 3:00 to 6:00 p.m. A short presentation will follow from 6:00 to 7:00 p.m. in the library auditorium, located in the basement.
